
As such, a Christian college takes your education seriously. Christian universities know just how high the

The world as we understand it through science constantly changes. Research and theory that were taught as fact in one era can give way when new data is discovered in the next.


A good college is obliged to teach its students the latest in science and scholarly advances, but a Christian col-
